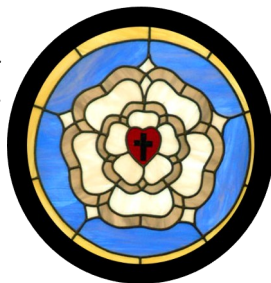
### A NOTE ABOUT "Morning Has Broken"

Many people, especially Baby Boomers, probably associate this song with the popular 1970's singer, Cat Stevens, and are perhaps curious how a 1970's pop song made it into hymnals. But in actuality, the song went from hymnals into popular music. Cat Stevens got the song from a hymnbook he found at a bookstore while looking for public domain song ideas when he was going through a slightly dry period and needed another song or two for his album, "Teaser And The Firecat."

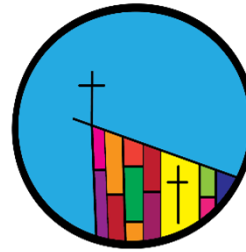
The melody is a traditional Scottish Gaelic tune known as "Bunessan," named for a small island town on the Isle of Mull in Scotland. Scottish children sang the 19th century Gaelic Christmas Carol, "Child in a Manger, Infant of Mary," to this melody. The words for this carol were written by the Scottish poet Mary MacDonal, who was born and lived near the village of Bunessan.

When the second edition of the English hymnal "Songs of Praise" was being prepared, the editors felt there was a need for a hymn to give thanks for each day. They asked the English poet and children's author, Eleanor Farjeon, to write a poem that could be set to the Scottish tune, "Bunessan." Drawing her inspiration from the village of Alfriston in East Sussex, she created "Morning Has Broken," which was then published in the hymnal in 1931.

The melody has been used for several other hymns in the ELW: "Baptized in Water" (ELW #456), "This Is a Day, Lord, Gladly Awaited" (ELW 586), and "Praise and Thanksgiving" (ELW #689).

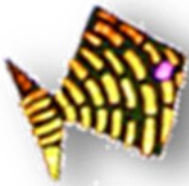
