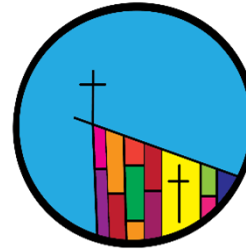


- Thanksgiving for **Gaelyn**, as her surgery was successful in eradicating the cancer and she is on her way to recovery
