



An actual reference to the ancient practice of bidding Farewell to Alleluia is found in ELW #318 Verse 3 "Alleluia, Song of Gladness" which contains a translation of an 11th century Latin text that compares an Alleluia-less Lent to the exile of the Israelites in Babylon.
