

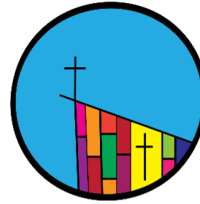

A note about today's Prelude: The lyrics for "There is a Happy Land" were written by Andrew Young (1807–1889), a Scottish schoolmaster, and first published in 1838. The melody is a tune arranged and published in 1850 by an American musician, Leonard P. Breedlove (est.1801–1900). This setting was composed by the American jazz pianist, George Shearing. It's one of only 9 compositions that he wrote for the organ.
