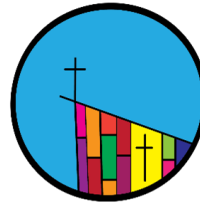


- **Bob**, undergoing chemo for colon cancer (*cousin of Sherise Stark*)

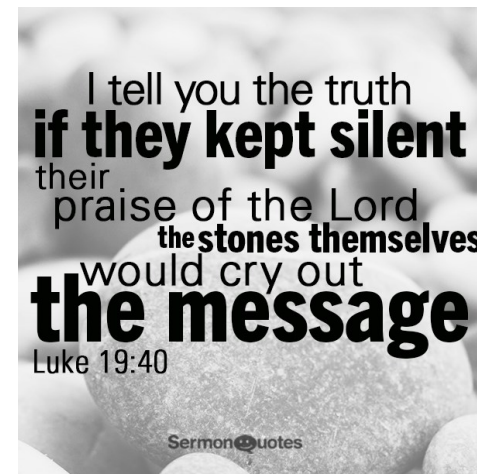
