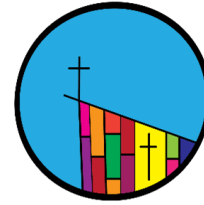


- **Sigrid**, who transferred recently to a memory care residence and is living into her new life surroundings. *(Pastor Andreas)*
