

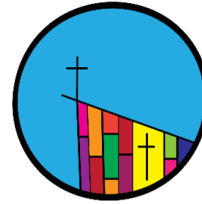
- **Susan** (John's sister in law), who has begun treatment for cancer, for her ongoing strength as a past cancer survivor (*John Sevcik*)
