

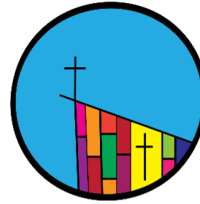
- **Rigoromo**, that he finds a path in life that is blessed and directed by God *(Larry & Elena Tilton)*

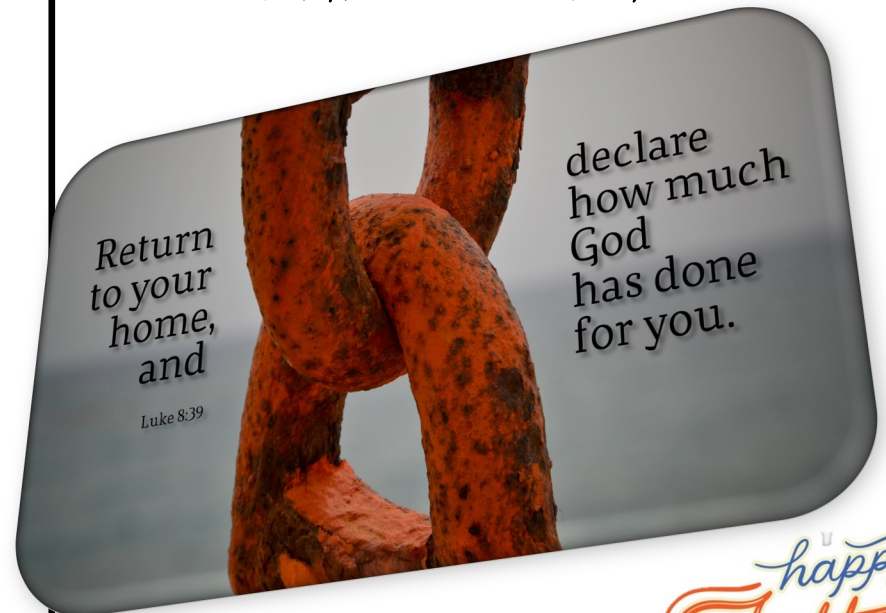
