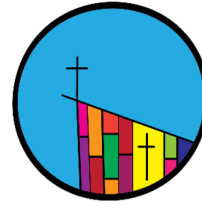

In the Old Testament book of Daniel, Michael leads the faithful dead to God's throne on the day of resurrection. During the Middle Ages, Michaelmas was a great religious feast with many popular traditions and coincided with the harvest in much of western Europe.
