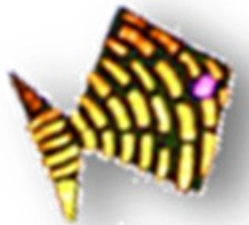


- Chi**—for successful response to now completed chemo treatment for thyroid cancer. (Sherise Stark)

- **May God give us all strength to deal with the unexpected happenings in life.**

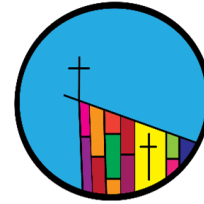
